Agreed Report: Friday December 15th 2023

- The new Board of Management has been constituted.
- CPSMA – Revised parental complaints procedures come into effect on January 1st 2024
- The Board of Management completed the annual review of the Child Safeguarding Statement. The Board utilised the revised template from the Department of Education. The new template will be circulated to all stakeholders in the school and will be displayed in the front porch of the school and in all classrooms.
